We also may disclose information about you to the following types of third parties:

- Any person acting in a fiduciary or representative capacity on your behalf (such as a trustee or IRA custodian).
- An affiliate providing administrative, customer assistance, clearing, operational, or other services.
- We also may disclose your non-public personal information to non-affiliated third parties as permitted or required by law. For example, we may disclose to law enforcement agencies or computer security consultants for the purpose of protecting against fraud and unauthorized transactions or in order to maintain the confidentiality of our records.
- On occasion, we may be required to provide information about you and your transactions to governmental agencies, self-regulatory organizations and similar bodies to fulfill legal and regulatory requirements.

Our staff, affiliates, representatives, and their staffs are required to follow our policies and procedures to keep your information secure, confidential, and prevent unauthorized use of your personal information. Our physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards have been reasonably designed to protect your information.

If we change our policies to permit Patrick M.
